

BIG HANDS TEAM UPDATE

God has enabled our Big Hands puppet team to reach out to even more people, this Christmas. One hundred and forty copies of our Christmas DVD have been sent out to various schools, churches, care homes and other groups all around the country including Wales and the Republic of Ireland. This is more than we ever expected so we are thankful to God for giving Praizin' Hands new opportunities. Good feedback has been received from various places which is an encouragement to our puppet team.

Big Hands have started rehearsing on zoom and although this way of rehearsing has many challenges, it has been wonderful to have time together and keep going! There is uncertainty to when the national lockdown will be lifted to allow the puppeteers to meet and rehearse properly but we are determined to get 'something' ready for Easter. Sadly, there is not enough time to get DVD's produced however, we plan to put an Easter presentation on our YouTube channel for the Easter week allowing schools, care homes and churches to access it. If the restrictions do not allow us to achieve this, then we will film it in the summer and put the Easter presentation on a DVD ready for Easter 2022. We will hopefully be back doing live performances in schools by then, but this means we will have a DVD for care homes and places further afield as well.

PSHE SCHOOLS PROJECT TEAM UPDATE

Our PSHE Schools project puppet team are currently meeting on Zoom to rehearse. We are working on our 'Internet Safety for KS1' presentation which is suitable for infant school children. Once the restrictions are lifted, we will be filming this presentation and putting it on YouTube so schools can access it for their children. It is important that children of all ages know how to keep themselves safe on the internet.

The project team are also working on a 'Talking about Problems' presentation suitable for KS2 children (Junior School). We are going to put this presentation on YouTube for schools to access. We felt that there is so much uncertainty in the world at the moment, that helping children to understand the importance of talking over problems with someone they can trust, is as important as ever.

LITTLE HANDS PUPPET TEAM UPDATE

Sadly, meeting in person with our Little Hands team was short lived as we had to make the decision to revert to meeting back on Zoom when the pandemic restrictions



were tightened, once again. This means, Little Hands were unable to film their song in the forest as planned for the beginning of November. This will still happen but when the restrictions are lifted once again. However, we continue to meet on Zoom to practise puppetry skills, play games and share a devotional

together and pray. We have a lovely group of young people and we long for the day we can meet back again in person.
