FORD BRITAIN TRUST GRANT

We have, this month, been awarded a grant of £1,000 to purchase a new sound system for when we are working in schools. Our current portable system must be approximately 10 years old so it will be great to have a new, more reliable system.

The Ford Britain Trust specifically supports the local communities around their factories. Although the transit factory in Southampton closed they still support the local area, enabling us to apply for the grant.
